Traffic and Lighting

Our current estimate is approximately forty people spread out over the course of a day. It won't be that different from a local restaurant that might see the same volume within two hours.

We are an environmentally and socially conscientious team that want to be good neighbors. We are committed to limited downward facing lighting, which is mandated by the planning board of Thomaston.

Building Size and Design

Our preliminary floor plan is for a building footprint of approximately 7,500 sq ft, which is equal to .17 of an acre. The second floor is over one wing, with plans for a rooftop community space over the other wing of the building.

Thomaston has produced twenty pages of 'Thomaston Green Design Standards' that our architect will need to consider as they complete the design for your health center. Our goal is to make the building as green as possible.
